

Peruvian Delegation is going to travel to Germany for taking part in the 4th Edition of the International Fair & Conference – Carbon Expo 2007

From May 2nd to 4th, it will be held in Köln, Germany, the 4th Edition of the Global Carbon Market -International Fair & Conference CARBON EXPO 2007, which is being jointly organised for the fourth time in succession by the World Bank, IETA (International Emissions Trading Association) and Koelnmesse GmbH. This trade fair, will be attended by more than 50 delegations of countries from all around the world, including Peru, which have been recognized by Point Carbon magazine, as one of the Top 10 more attractive countries for developing Clean Development Mechanism project activities, due to the high quality in the formulation of Peruvian CDM projects.

Peruvian delegation, “*Fourth Mission for Promotion of Environmental Investments*” is annually promoted and organized by the National Environmental Fund – FONAM, and is formed by 10 representatives of the most important Peruvian companies that, to the date, are developing projects for the Clean Development Mechanism of the Kyoto Protocol.

Peru will have a stand where FONAM will promote the National CDM Project Portfolio, which has, to the date, 70 projects in Energy and Forest sectors. These projects represent new investments for the country of around US\$ 1500 million dollars and exports of US\$ 40 millions every year.
