



Peruvian delegation will participate in the 6th. International Carbon Fair- Carbon Expo 2009 in Barcelona

For sixth consecutive year will be held from 27 to May 29 this year, the 6th. International Fair of Carbon Market - CARBON EXPO 2009, being hosted this time by the city of Barcelona, Spain. This year, the organizers are the World Bank, the International Emissions Trading (IETA), the Cologne Fair (Koelnmesse) and Fira Barcelona.

Last year, 258 companies from over 60 countries and 3000 visitors from over 115 countries met in a 9400 m² area to discuss anything that covers carbon market, from its environmental impact to its importance within the economy world. The numbers give an idea of the importance that have acquired carbon markets as an environmental tool, but also the economic importance of these instruments as a mean to face climate change through technology transfer and mobilization of financial flows.

The Peruvian delegation, Sixth Mission for Environmental Investment Promotion, will consist of representatives of FONAM addition, representatives of companies that are developing projects which are applying for Clean Development Mechanism under the Kyoto Protocol.

The Sixth Mission for Environmental Investment Promotion is promoted and organized by the National Environment Fund - FONAM, will have a post financed by the World Bank and will be attending the fair with a portfolio of over 130 projects in energy and forest sectors, which represent new investment to the country for more than 6 billion U.S.
